Application of Joe Weber

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah state prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of burglary in the third degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the seventh day of August A. D. 1925, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in second judicial district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James N. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from six months to three years in State's prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the State's prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joseph Weber I was convicted under the name of Joseph Weber

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except several similar felonies in other states.
