First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Sept 22nd day of
A. D. 1924, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in the Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James W. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
from One to Twenty (1-20) years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joe E. Evans D. Att. prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Roy Clarence Scott.
I was convicted under the name of Roy Clarence Scott

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Allan - First name unknown.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none.
