Application of Catarino Martinez.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Manslaughter.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of April
A. D. 1923, at Provo, County of Grand
and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Bilworth presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to be indeterminate
Sentence - from 1 to 10 yrs. with recommend to 1 yr.
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison -
on the 16th day of April 1923.

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Young of Box Elder County prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Catarino Martinez
I was convicted under the name of Catarino Martinez.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: No one -

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this -
Dear Sirs in my trouble which was
forced upon me - I had to act in self
defense - I gave my self over to the Sheriff's
office at Provo - and before the court I plead
guilty to manslaughter with the recommend
