

Application of Ray Manley

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of Dec A. D. 1922, at St George County of Washington and State of Utah, in fifth ~~5th~~ Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Knox presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from one year to twenty and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable W. M. B. Higgins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Raymond Manley.

I was convicted under the name of Raymond Manley.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Floyd E. Harris

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except 14 months in Reform school.

I am asking for Termination owing to the fact that the Federal Dept are admitting my Release from this Prison thanking you for yours.
