

Application of Floyd E. Harris

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of Dec A. D. 1922, at St George County of Washington and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Knox presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one, twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable W. B. Higgins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Floyd Earnest Harris I was convicted under the name of Floyd E. Harris

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Raymond Manley

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none (Remarks)

I am asking for Termination owing to the fact that the federal officers are awaiting my release from this Prison. Hoping you will give this your best consideration
