

Application of J. C. Cooper.

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Embezzlement.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of May A. D. 1926, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christenson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve an indeterminate term from one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable District Attorney Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James C. Cooper, I was convicted under the name of James C. Cooper.
