Application of George McDowell

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First -- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the Twenty-first day of February A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third district court. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge L. B. Wight presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to An indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth -- Honorable E. A. Rogers, prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is George Conklin McDowell. I was convicted under the name of E. C. Clark.

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: E. A. Harrison, and L. E. Riggs.

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except NONE.
