Application of Howard Thomas

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 20 day of March A. D. 1925, at Castle Gate County of Emery and State of Utah, in Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christianson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from one to 20 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Thomas Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Howard Thomas I was convicted under the name of Howard Thomas

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except I was taken to the State Industrial School the 7th day of October 1921. I was released from away on the 3rd day of December 1922. have been gone since then. I plead guilty to this offence.
