I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am ~~being held~~ ^{imprisoned} in the State Prison of Utah under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder in the First Degree.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of January A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to be Executed February 20th, 1925.

and thereafter was imprisoned in ~~the~~ and am now confined in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Henry C. Hett.

I was convicted under the name of Henry C. Hett alias George Allen.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Arthur Hayes.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense ~~except~~ and I request that I may be permitted to personally appear before your Honorable Board of Pardons.
