First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of Jan. A. D. 1925, at Ogden City Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Five years Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. C. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Herbert V. Logan I was convicted under the name of Herbert V. Logan

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Breaking seal on R.R. car, Federal charge sentenced to Five months in Weber Co. Jail, Came to Utah State Prison direct from there.
