First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of third degree burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of January A. D. 1924, at Big Horn City County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in First District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Bolton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of six months to three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Le Roy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Tom Gibson I was convicted under the name of Tom Gibson
