Application of Jase Byrd

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary,

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 31st day of July, A. D. 1924 at Ogden Utah, County of Weber and State of Utah, in 2nd District, Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. M. Hissell presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 1 to 20 years in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable District Atty. General prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Jase Byrd I was convicted under the name of Jase Byrd.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except misdemeanors including petty larceny, speeding, operating a machine without drivers license, disturbing peace.
