Application of Frank J. Bartlett

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Theft of Automobile

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the fourth day of November A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Fair Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to From Ninety Days to Ten Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison since including the eleventh day of November 1922

Fourth-- Honorable one of Mr. Roy's assistants (Name unknown to me) prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank James Bartlett I was convicted under the name of Frank J. Bartlett

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None
