Application of Herman Smith

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a release of imprisonment and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of Sept A. D. 1924, at Cogden Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimble presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One year to ten years.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state prison.

Fourth-- Honorable J. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Herman Lee Smith I was convicted under the name of Herman Smith

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: no one to my knowing
