Application of George Manousos

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The State Penitentiary under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempt to commit murder

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of September A. D. 1924, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from 1 to 20 years in the State Penitentiary and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary from September 19th, 1924 until March 27th, 1925 at which time I was paroled to Mr. T. J. Parmley of Winter Quarters, Utah

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Manousos I was convicted under the name of George Manousos
