Application of John B. Thorpe

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. M. McCreary presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John B. Thorpe I was convicted under the name of John B. Thorpe

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Forgery
