County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to an indeterminate  
sentence  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable Joseph D. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Richard Neubauer  
I was convicted under the name of John Markins
