Application of James Bray

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5 day of November  
A. D. 1921, at Ordgen County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James M. Kimpell presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Bray  
I was convicted under the name of James Gray

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
