Application of Walter P. Mason

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Rehearing for Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of November A. D. 1924, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Jos. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Walter P. Mason

I was convicted under the name of Walter P. Mason

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Petty
