Application of Joe Taylor

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of assault with a deadly weapon

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of September A. D. 1916; at Salt Lake City Utah County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Utah Superior Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable C. W. Harre presiding

Third—I was sentenced to intermittent service and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable C. C. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Joe Taylor I was convicted under the name of Joe Taylor

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this is my first time in Prison
