Application of David S. Hogge.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 24th day of November A. D. 1920, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. W. Agee presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable S. P. Dobbs prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is David S. Hogge. I was convicted under the name of David S. Hogge.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
