Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of Oct
A. D. 1916, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Mr. Morris presiding

Third—I was sentenced to State Prison

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of William Snow
