Application of Lovell Hale,

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in County Jail at Salt Lake County, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of petty larceny,

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of January A. D. 1920, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Justice's Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Henry C. Lund presiding

Third—I was sentenced to six months imprisonment and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail at Salt Lake City; and that on February 3, 1920, since said imprisonment I have had a thumb amputated.

Fourth—Honorable Asst. Co. Atty. Elsmore prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Lovell Hale, I was convicted under the name of Lovell Hale,
