Application of H.A. Sivertson,

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Salt Lake County Jail under conviction and sentence on a charge of embezzlement

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of November A. D. 1917, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Justice Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Herbert Van Dam presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Four Months in the County Jail and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail

Fourth—Honorable Atty. Richards prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Herman A. Sivertson I was convicted under the name of H.A. Sivertson

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: No one.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
