Application of H. W. Bigler.

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 24 day of Sept A. D. 1915, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable G. B. Morgan presiding

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. M. Donald prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Henry William Bigler I was convicted under the name of H. W. Bigler
