Application of Frank Gross

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of petit larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of September A. D. 1920, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in City Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable H.C.Lund presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve Six months in the County jail and thereafter was imprisoned in the County jail, Salt Lake county, Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable F.W.James prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank Gross I was convicted under the name of Frank Gross

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Frank McCoy

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
