under conviction and sentence on a charge of Robbery in Degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of June
A. D., 1917, at Price County of Garfield
and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Agan presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate sentence
from six months to three years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. Dolbe prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Charles C. Stewart
I was convicted under the name of Charles C. Stewart

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Price
