First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Carrying a Dangerous Weapon

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 29 day of December
A. D. 1915, at Provo County of Utah
1917 and State of Utah, in Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. B. Morgan presiding

Third—I was sentenced to State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. H. Donald prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is John Lawhorn
I was convicted under the name of John Lawhorn
