Application of J. Herman,

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Salt Lake County Jail
under conviction and sentence on a charge of having Opium in his possession

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of January
A. D. 1918, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the 3rd. District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Evans presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Four and One Half months in jail

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail

Fourth—Honorable Atty. Richards prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is John Herman,

I was convicted under the name of J. Herman,

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows: No one.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
