Application of Ignasio Marquez

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Rehearing and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of Oct. A. D. 1913, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7th Dist. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable H. A. christensan presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. W. cherry prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Jausio Marquez I was convicted under the name of Same

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except None
