and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison  
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of Feb'y  
A. D. 1917, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Lewis Brown presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Indefinite sentence  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Wilson McCarthy prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Geo. Cooper  
I was convicted under the name of Geo. Cooper
