Application of Geo. W. Caryle

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of June A. D. 1916, at Pice, Utah County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7th District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge A. H. Christensen presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of six months to three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. W. Cherry prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Geo. W. Caryle I was convicted under the name of Geo. W. Caryle

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Third Degree Burglary
