Application of Jack O'Hara

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a rehearing for termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of grand larceny.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th, day of June, A. D. 1916, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd. district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. L. Ritchie presiding

Third—I was sentenced to a term of from one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Jack O'Hara I was convicted under the name of " "
