I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 10 day of September
A. D. 1917, at Odgen County of Weber
and State of Utah, in the second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge A. M. Agee presiding

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence
of from one (1) to ten (10) years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Prosecuting Att. Dobbs prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Allan Cole
I was convicted under the name of Wm. A. Cole

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows: Alfred Johnson

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except minor
offenses
