Application of Evan Anderton.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of November A. D. 1916, at Richfield, County of Sevier, and State of Utah, in Sixth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Jos. H. Erickson presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable John L. Sevy, Jr. prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Evans Anderton. I was convicted under the name of Evans Anderton.

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
