Application of Arthur Atkinson.

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in on Parole
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of March
A. D. 1917, at Salt Lake County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. Louis Brown presiding

Third—I was sentenced to 3yrs Three Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State
Penitentiary
