I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Dismissal
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the ^{21st} 28 day of ^{J. 11} June
A. D. 1917, at Ordun County of Sevier
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. C. Pratt presiding

Third—I was sentenced to one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable S. J. Dobbins prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is J. Douglas Colby
I was convicted under the name of J. D. Colby

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except present conviction
