and State of Utah, in Justice Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. A. Stewart presiding

Third—I was sentenced to two years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. A. Stewart prosecuted the case.
