To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Penitentiary  
under conviction and sentence on a charge of 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May  
A. D. 1917, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in 3<sup>rd</sup> District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Lewis Brown presiding

Third—I was sentenced to One Year Jail  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable Nelson McCarthy prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Stillman
