and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah  
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Destroying Jail Property

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of July  
A. D. 1916, at Farmington County of Utah  
and State of Utah, in A. Judicial Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Howell presiding

Third—I was sentenced to and indeterminate  
term of from One to five years.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable \_\_\_\_\_ prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Fred Hitesman.

I was convicted under the name of Fred Hitesman.

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense ~~except~~ before.  
I have worked at the State road  
camp eight months. My record  
here is first class. I am allowed  
10 days off from each month for good  
conduct. I have served practically 2 years 2 months.
