Application of Hugh L. McLeod

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Embezzlement

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of February A. D. 1918, at Price Utah County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7th District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Knox Patterson prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Hugh Lee McLeod I was convicted under the name of C.R. Hill

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: No others.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Have never before been arrested on any charge.
