I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake Co. Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of April, A. D. 1920, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Harold M. Stephens presiding

Third—I was sentenced to One year in the County Jail of Salt Lake County and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail of Salt Lake County where I have been imprisoned since my arrest February 22, 1920.
