Application of Ed. Franklin, Colton, Utah.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of September A. D. 1912, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Fred C. Loofbourow presiding

Third—I was sentenced to 20 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Edward Franklin I was convicted under the name of Edward Franklin

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Assault
