Application of Harry Robert Lockard

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The County Jail under conviction and sentence on a charge of Petty Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of December A. D. 1917, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The Honorable Judge Brown's court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Brown's presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Four months

and thereafter was imprisoned in the The county jail of Salt Lake City in Salt Lake County Utah.

Fourth—Honorable Wilson Mc Carthy prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Harry Robert Lockard I was convicted under the name of Harry Robert Lockard
