Application of Walter Butler, Thompson Springs, Utah.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Forgery.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 13 day of Feb. A. D. 1917, at Pocatello County of Utah and State of Utah, in Third Dist. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Mr. Mc Carthy presiding

Third—I was sentenced to a term of a indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Eugene Browne prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Walter Butler I was convicted under the name of Walter Butler

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: There was a man of a 45 years of age who got me into this by giving me the check to get cashed and I did not know that it was not good.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except one in the State of Washington on a frame up.
