I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Salt Lake County Jail
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Obtaining money by false pretense.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st. day of December
A. D. 1917, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Justice Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Justice VanDam presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Six Months in the County Jail

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail

Fourth—Honorable Atty. Richards prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William M. Samuelson

I was convicted under the name of Wm. Samuelson

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows: Mrs. Frank Warren

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except Highway Robbery
