Application of Louis Vampa

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Manslaughter

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of August
A. D. 1915, at Moab County of Grand
and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. H. Christensen presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. W. Cherry prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Louis Vampa

I was convicted under the name of Louis Vampa

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows: Dominick Cibrario

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
