

Salt Lake City, Utah, April 4/29 1918

Application of Floyd Holliman

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the fourth day of January  
A. D. 1917, at Leavitt, County of Summit  
and State of Utah, in Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding

Third—I was sentenced to from six months to three years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Ken Patton prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is James Floyd Holliman  
I was convicted under the name of James

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as  
follows: the various persons connected with the same case

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except as convicted  
on a similar charge of burglary in third degree  
in this State
