Application of Robert D. Dugan

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd degree burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 11 day of Dec. A. D. 1917, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. L. Brown presiding

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable William G. Corty prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Robert Dugan I was convicted under the name of Robert Dugan

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Ed. Sullivan

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
