Application of Van E. Fredrickson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary Second Dg.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of November A. D. 1917, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial Dist Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. R. Brown presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Indefinite Sentence

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison

Fourth—Honorable Wilson McCarty prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Van Ernest Fredrickson I was convicted under the name of Van E. Fredrickson

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Roy Saefer, James McGinnis, Louland.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except None
